Winter Campout

January 28 - 30, 2005

The Winter Campout will be at Camp Y-Noah again this year. Activities will include sled riding (weather permitting), winter hiking, BB guns, horseback riding, a skit competition, and a torch march. Be sure to bring extra warm clothing.



The cost will be \$110 for father and (1) child with a charge of \$35 for each additional child. Horseback riding will be available to ALL children (ages 8 and over - trail ride \$10/rider and ages 7 and under - ring ride \$5/rider). Plan on arriving on Friday evening at 7:00 p.m. to get your cabin assignment.

Each child should bring their own sled (please, NO METAL RUNNER SLEDS, for safety reasons). Please have the owner's NAME clearly marked on each sled.

Directions: Take I-77 South about 30 miles to Exit 120, Arlington Road. Drive 6 miles South and turn Right on Mt. Pleasant Road. Drive about 1/2 mile and turn right, into the Camp Y-Noah entrance.
